THIS TOURNAMENT IS OPEN TO 40 TEAMS, WHICH INCLUDES THE 10 TEAMS THAT EARNED A PAID ENTRY FROM LAST YEARS EVENT. Once 32 additional teams have secured their tournament entry we will begin a wait list. Entries will Close December 7th!! All MHSAA and MHSIBCA rules and conditions will be followed. The tournament committee's decision will be final on all disputes. NO BLUE JEANS will be allowed in the bowler's area!!! Cost of admission to this event will be \$5.00 for all spectators and visitors. We will offer a 50/50, 60/40 one winner and with the 60/40 we will also raffle two premium bowling balls. WE WILL BE COMPETING ON THE NEW KEGAL PHANTOM 2 PATTERN and we will not reoil between sessions.

Format: We will follow in reverse order the new Regional team event as our qualifier...2 regular team games followed by 2 4 game baker sets. This year's event will have a boy's team on one pair and their companion girl's team on the pair next door. Movement: we will use a 4 lane pod format after the first team game both teams on the same pair will move right or left (1-2 to lanes 3-4, 3-4 to 1-2). Same after the 2nd game the opposite move, there will be another move after the first 4 game baker block. Then the teams bowl another 4 game baker block. All baker games will count toward the total score. If there are 16 or more teams in a bracket (boys or girls), the cut will be 16. If there are 11 or less teams, the cut to the second round will be 8. Match play head-to-head will constitute a change this year, a total pin 2 game alternating lane baker games, with the winner advancing to the next round. Ties will be broken with a 5 frame baker roll off. The higher seeded team will dictate starting lane choice. The third round will be a stepladder format with the 4 remaining teams. The highest seeded team remaining will become the top seed and be assured of a place in the final match. The lowest seed will bowl the 3rd lowest seed in a one baker game shoot out the winner advances. That winner will bowl the second seed also a one game winner advances to the finals. The finals will be a best 2 out of 3 alternating baker games. The top 4 boys' and girls' teams will receive Team plaques and team members will receive individual medals. Each team can substitute only twice in each team game, but not for the same player. The 2 team games bowled will determine the 7-member All Tournament Team in both the boy's and girl's division. The All Tournament Team members will receive plaques. Team Rosters are due December 3rd and payment is also due! One coach only will be allowed in the bowlers' area for qualifying, 2 coaches for Match Play... Team rosters may change up to the time of check-in.
